

POTTER COUNTY WEATHER CLOSING POLICY

On 11-09-2020, the Potter County Commissioners Court adopted the following policy regarding closing of Potter County facilities and offices due to inclement weather or poor road conditions.

1. If the Amarillo Independent School District (AISD) cancels or delays on-campus classes due to inclement weather or poor road conditions, Potter County facilities and offices will likewise be closed, or their opening delayed, without further order of the court.
2. If AISD schools are not in session during inclement weather or poor road conditions, or if AISD chooses not to cancel or delay on-campus classes due to such conditions, the Potter County Judge, in his or her sole discretion, may order closure or delayed opening of Potter County facilities and offices. In that event, the Potter County Judge will inform local media of such order for release to the public.
3. If inclement weather or poor road conditions develop during normal business hours, each elected official and department head is authorized to close his or her department or office for the remainder of that day as he or she deems advisable in the interest of the safety of Potter County's employees and the public.
