

## Procedure to Obtain a Rebuilt Title / Resume Operations for Salvaged Vehicles

Step 1: Complete the enclosed [Form VTR-441](#) and send it with the applicable \$8.00 fee (check or money order) along with the original title to TXDMV at the following address:

TXDMV will issue a Salvage Vehicle Title and mail it to the owner or lienholder.

Step 2: Complete vehicle repairs and keep the receipts for all repair parts and services.

Step 3: Obtain a new vehicle safety inspection after the repairs are completed and **AFTER** receipt of the Salvage Vehicle Title. Be sure to request an Identification Certificate (form VI-30).

Step 4: Submit the Salvage Vehicle Title to your County Tax Assessor-Collector's office along with:

- A properly completed [Form 130-U](#) , *Application for Texas Certificate of Title*
- A [Form VTR-61](#), *Rebuilt Affidavit*, recording component parts used (and their origin)
- Vehicle Inspection Report (VIR)
- Proof of insurance that meets Texas Liability Minimums

Application fee, Registration renewal fees (if applicable), and a \$65.00 Rebuilder Fee will be assessed.

**UPON completion of Step 4, the vehicle title will be appropriately branded and the vehicle may again be operated on public roadways.**
