- 1. **APPROVAL OF MINUTES:** Recognize the minutes from the September 28, 2015 Potter County Commissioners' Court meeting.
- 2. **BUDGET AMENDMENT**: To consider and act upon a budget amendment for the fiscal year 2015-2016. [Hood]
- 3. **VOUCHERS:** To consider and act upon the approval of the payment of vouchers processed by the County Auditor's office for the period of September 23, 2015 through October 7, 2015. [Hood]
- 4. **INSURANCE REPORT:** To recognize the insurance fund report. [Holland]
- 5. **WORKERS' COMPENSATION INSURANCE**: To hear a report from Steve Lapp with Willis of Texas, regarding Workers' Compensation Insurance Renewal for 2015-16 and:
 - a. Consider and act upon the recommendation to award the Workers' Compensation contract to Texas Political Subdivision for the amount of \$164,091 for the period of November 1, 2015 through October 31, 2016. This fee includes the fee for Willis HRH as the County's broker to be paid separately by the County.
