THE FOLLOWING MATTERS WILL COME BEFORE THE POTTER COUNTY COMMISSIONERS' COURT ON MONDAY, APRIL 13, 2015, AT 9:00 A.M. IN THE POTTER COUNTY COMMISSIONERS' COURTROOM, LOCATED AT 500 S. FILLMORE, ROOM 106, AMARILLO, POTTER COUNTY, TEXAS.

- 1. **APPROVAL OF MINUTES:** Approval of the minutes from the March 23, 2015 Potter County Commissioners' Court meeting.
- 2. **BUDGET AMENDMENT:** To consider and act upon budget amendments for the 2014-2015 fiscal year. [Hood]
- 3. **VOUCHERS:** To consider and act upon the approval of the payment of vouchers processed by the County Auditor's office for the period of March 18 through April 8, 2015. [Hood]
- 4. **QUARTERLY BUDGET COMPARISON:** To recognize the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter comparison report for FY14 and FY15. [Hood]
- 5. **INSURANCE REPORT:** To recognize the insurance fund report. [Holland]
- 6. **TIMECLOCK PLUS**: To hear a report on TimeClock Plus and take any action necessary. (Holland)
- 7. **INSURANCE ADVISORY COMMITTEE:** To consider and act upon the recommendation of the Insurance Advisory Committee to adopt resolution option #2 in response to the Affordable Care Act (ACA) maximum out of pocket requirement resulting in a synchronized plan and benefit year, pro-rated deductible and reimbursement as stated in Texas Association of Counties correspondence dated 4/2/15. (Insurance Advisory Committee)
- 8. **COUNTY & DISTRICT CLERKS' ASSOCIATION OF TEXAS:** To recognize the Certificate of Completion Awarded to Caroline Woodburn for completing the required 20 hours of continuing education for 2014 as prescribed in Section 51.605 of the Texas Government Code.
- 9. **BUDGET CALENDAR FY16:** To recognize the proposed budget calendar for FY16. [Hood]
- 10. **TAX OFFICE:** To consider and act upon a tax refund for over-payment of taxes. [Aylor, Hood]

- 11. **CONTRACT-DETENTION CENTER-PSYCHIATRIC SERVICES**: To approve the contract for psychiatric services for inmates in the Detention Center. (*Comment*: This is a budgeted item. - 12. **BURN BAN**: To consider and act upon imposing a burn for a period not to exceed ninety (90) days due to dry conditions. [Kemp]
- 13. **FIRE STATION PROJECT**: To hear a report from Parkhill, Smith & Cooper, Inc., (engineering and architectural firm), concerning the 50% construction documents and to take any action necessary. [Head, Fitzpatrick, Carroway]
- 14. **LOCAL GOVERNMENT CORPORATION**: To provide an update on the Local Government Corporation [Murguia].
- 15. **FORMAL PROPOSAL RENEWAL:** To consider and act upon renewing Formal Proposal #1032-11 Independent Auditor Services for an additional one year term from 6/1/2015 through 5/31/2016. Term extension and pricing is as outlined in the original proposal. [Harder, Hood]
- 16. **FORMAL BID RENEWAL:** To consider and act upon renewing Formal Bid #1087-14 Painting and Surface Refinish Services for an additional one year term from 5/1/2015 through 4/20/2016. Pricing is unchanged from the previous contract term. [Harder]

- 21. **JAIL REPORT**: To hear a report on the Potter County Detention Center and to take any action necessary.
- 22. **COUNTY INSURANCE ITEMS**: To consider and act upon any insurance claims, accidents, etc. against the county.
