- 5. **BUDGETED SALARIES BY POSITION:** To consider and act upon the transfer of funds between positions. [Sims, Hood]
- 6. **WESTLAW CONTRACT FOR JUDGES AND PROSECUTORS.** To consider and act upon a contract with Thomson-Reuters to upgrade to an all-inclusive Westlaw government package for legal research. Cost and annual increase to remain the same as our current agreement. [Hood]
