- 1. **RECOGNITION OF MINUTES:** Recognize the minutes from the February 27, 2017 Potter County Commissioners' Court meeting.
- 2. **VOUCHERS:** To consider and act upon the approval of the payment of vouchers processed by the County Auditor's office for the period of February 22, 2017 through March 8, 2017. [Hood]
- 3. **COUNTY HEALTH INSURANCE:** To discuss reinstating District Judges to the county insurance plan and take any action necessary. [Hood]
